

REGISTRATION

Starting with this 2019 - 2020 season, Innisfail Minor Hockey Association (IMHA) is offering registration online using 'TeamSnap'. This will streamline the registration process by allowing the option of paying by credit card. **(Offline payments will still be accepted by cheque or cash in the IMHA office.)**

You must have an existing 'TeamSnap' account or create one in the registration process.

RESIDENT PLAYER REGISTRATION

Use this registration if your player is:

- A current resident in Innisfail or within the Immediate Surrounding Area
- Innisfail Minor Hockey is their 'Resident' Association
- A returning player from Pee wee through Midget

In order to complete this registration, **you must have the following:**

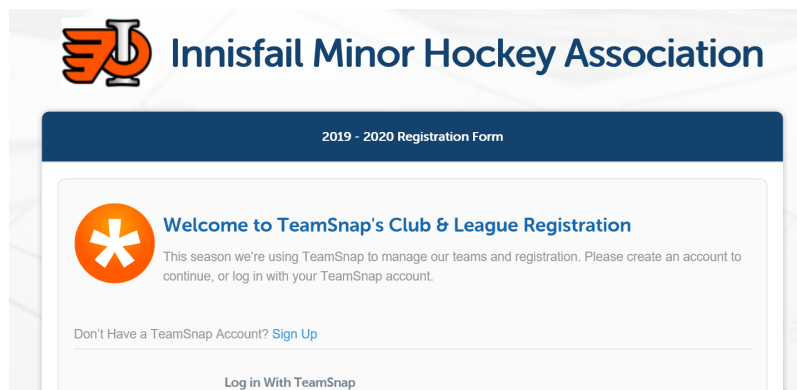
1. TeamSnap Account: <https://TeamSnap.com>
2. Player's Hockey Canada ID Number: <https://ehockey.hockeycanada.ca/ehockey/account/login.aspx>
3. Respect In Sport Parent **Valid** Certificate Number: <https://hockeyalbertaparent.respectgroupinc.com/>

Please check the Expiry Date for your 'Respect In Sport Parent' as it expires every 4 years.

FIRST TIME REGISTERING FOR MINOR HOCKEY

You will need **two** things before you can register with our association:

1. First will require a new Hockey Canada ID Number that you will obtain through our Executive Director. Please send an email request to: innisfailminorhockey@gmail.com & include the following information:
 - The Player's Name
 - The Player's Date of Birth
 - The Player's address (If you live in a rural location, please also send your legal land description)

You will then be provided your Hockey Canada ID and will be able to register your player with IMHA once you complete the Respect in Sport Certificate (see #2)

2. You will be required to complete the 'Respect In Sport Parent' Program to obtain your certificate number before registration can be completed (<https://hockeyalbertaparent.respectgroupinc.com/>). There is a \$30.00 fee to obtain this certificate that is mandated by Hockey Alberta. The course takes approximately 1 hour to complete online. ***This certificate is good for 4 years and can be attached to all your children playing hockey; you do not need to complete for each player***

NEW TO INNISFAIL MINOR HOCKEY – PLAYED IN ANOTHER MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION LAST YEAR

Members who are new to IMHA (but exist in a different association) ***will not be able to register online until the player is transferred to IMHA*** through the Hockey Canada Registry. If you attempt to register online, you will receive an error as you player's Hockey Alberta ID is not associated with us. In order to register online, you will need to first be transferred to IMHA. To transfer a player to IMHA you will need to submit one of the following forms, dependent on the described circumstances:

- If you reside in another community or association, you will need to complete a Player Movement Form: https://www.hockeyalberta.ca/uploads/source/Forms/2016-17%20NEW%20LOGO/2017-2018_Player_Movement_Process__Form.pdf
- If you have recently moved or will be moving within the IMHA boundaries, you will need to complete the Parent/Guardian Declaration Form: https://www.hockeyalberta.ca/uploads/source/Forms/2016-17%20NEW%20LOGO/General/Parent-Guardian_Declaration_Form.pdf

If either of these situations apply to you, please complete the applicable form and submit it via email to: innisfailminorhockey@gmail.com Once you have been transferred to IMHA, you will be able to register online

- Register before June 30th to take advantage of the payment plan
 - Register before June 30th to avoid an increase in fees from Atom through Midget
 - **NOTE: You must register with IMHA before forms can be signed to try-out in other Associations**
